

How To 'Grep' in powershell

The rapid method:

```
get-process | findstr foo
```

The proper way:

```
Get-Process | Where-Object {$_.Name -like '*foo*'} | Select-String "foo"
```

Example, for display thunderbird process:

```
get-process | findstre "thunderbird"
```
